NOTICE INVITING TENDER

Sealed Tenders affixed with Court Fee Stamp of Rs. 8.25 (Rupees Eight and Twenty-Five Paise only) are hereby invited from eligible, Government-registered firms/suppliers/agencies for the supply, delivery, and installation (wherever applicable) of the Road Safety Equipment specified herein, for use in enforcement and road safety activities under the District Road Safety Committee (DRSC), Sonitpur District. Bidders must carefully read all terms and conditions before submitting their Tender.

1. REQUIREMENTS:

2. TECHNICAL SPECIFICATIONS

All items must strictly conform to the following minimum technical specifications. Bids not meeting these specifications shall be summarily rejected.

2.1 Road Divider (Reflective, Heavy-Duty)

- Constructed from durable, UV-resistant material (HDPE or equivalent) capable of withstanding continuous outdoor use.
- Must have high-intensity retro-reflective strips/panels on all visible sides meeting IRC or equivalent standards.
- Dimensions: Minimum 1 metre in length, suitable for traffic regulation and channelization.
- Stackable / interlocking design preferred for ease of deployment and storage.
- Must carry BIS mark or equivalent national/international quality certification.
- Colour: Fluorescent orange/yellow with white reflective strips.

2.2 Wheel Locker (Vehicle Immobilizer)

- Constructed from heavy-duty steel with anti-tamper locking mechanism.
- Portable and operable by a single enforcement officer.
- Adjustable jaw width to fit cars, SUVs, light commercial vehicles and two-wheelers.

4. Must include a dedicated key/unlock mechanism; master-key arrangement to be provided to the District Administration.
5. Corrosion-resistant finish (powder-coated or galvanized).
6. Supplied with carry bag/case for storage and transport.

2.3 Breath Analyser (Evidential / Screening Grade)

1. Must comply with IS 11552:1986 or the latest BIS standard applicable to breath analyzers, or equivalent approved standard.
2. Capable of detecting Blood Alcohol Concentration (BAC) range: 0.00% to 0.40% BAC or better.
3. Integrated thermal printer / Bluetooth-enabled printer for generating printed result slips.
4. Result slip to display: date, time, BAC reading, device serial number and operator ID.
5. Battery-operated with rechargeable lithium-ion battery (minimum 500 tests per charge).
6. Mouthpiece disposables: minimum 200 mouthpieces per unit to be supplied along with the device.
7. Calibration certificate from an accredited laboratory to be furnished at the time of delivery.
8. Manufacturer's minimum warranty: 2 (Two) years from the date of acceptance.
9. Supplier to provide on-site training for operating personnel and a comprehensive user manual in English/Assamese.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Only bids submitted by firms/suppliers/agencies fulfilling all of the following criteria shall be considered:

1. Valid Registration with the Government of Assam or relevant State/Central Government authority as a registered firm/supplier.
2. Valid Trade License for the relevant trade/business.
3. GST Registration Certificate and Up-to-date GST filing of last 3(three) financial years.
4. PAN Card of the firm/proprietor.
5. Income Tax Returns (ITR) filed for the last three (3) financial years.
6. The firm/agency must not be blacklisted or debarred by any Government body at the time of bidding. A self-declaration to this effect must be submitted.
7. Prior experience in supply of similar Road Safety / Traffic Management equipment is desirable; documentary proof to be attached.

Note: All documents must be self-attested. Failure to submit any required document shall result in disqualification.

4. SUBMISSION INSTRUCTIONS

1. The Tender shall be submitted in a sealed envelope superscribed "TENDER FOR ROAD SAFETY EQUIPMENT — NIQ No. E. 175041 MJ/159/2026-MAG-SON/03".
2. The sealed envelope must be submitted in person or by registered post/courier to: The Office of the District Commissioner, Sonitpur, Tezpur — 784001, Assam.
3. The sealed tenders will be received at the office of the undersigned up to 3:00 PM of 07-07-2026 and will be opened at 3:30 PM on the same day in the Chamber of the Additional District Commissioner (Transport), Office of the District Commissioner, Sonitpur, in the

presence of the participating firms or their duly authorised representatives who may choose to attend. Tenders received after the stipulated date and time shall not be entertained under any circumstances. Tenders received after the stipulated date and time shall not be entertained under any circumstances.

4. Telegraphic, facsimile, email, or oral Tenders shall not be accepted.
5. Each bidder may submit only ONE Tender. Submission of multiple Tenders by the same firm or its affiliated entity shall lead to disqualification of all such bids.

5. FINANCIAL TERMS & PAYMENT CONDITIONS

5.1 The quoted rates must be INCLUSIVE of all applicable taxes (GST, etc.), transportation charges, loading/unloading, insurance in transit, and delivery to the designated location within Sonitpur District as communicated by the undersigned.

5.2 No price escalation shall be permitted after submission of the Tender under any circumstances.

5.3 Payment will be released ONLY after satisfactory delivery, physical verification, and written acceptance by the authorised committee/officer of the District Administration.

5.4 Payment to the selected firm/supplier shall be subject to statutory deductions (TDS, etc.) as applicable under prevailing tax laws.

5.5 No advance payment shall be made.

5.6 In case of price comparison, the L1 (Lowest Evaluated Bid) principle shall apply, subject to technical compliance.

6. DELIVERY, INSTALLATION & PERFORMANCE

6.1 The selected firm/agency must complete supply and delivery of all items within **14 (Fourteen)** days from the date of issuance of the Work Order / Supply Order.

6.2 The supplier shall be solely responsible for safe transportation, delivery, and installation (wherever applicable) at the designated site(s) within Sonitpur District.

6.3 Risk and title of the goods shall remain with the supplier until delivery is accepted in writing by the authorised officer.

6.4 Liquidated Damages (LD): In the event of delay in delivery beyond the stipulated period, LD shall be levied at the rate of 0.5% (half percent) of the contract value per week of delay, subject to a maximum of 10% (ten percent) of the total contract value, after which the District Administration reserves the right to cancel the order and forfeit any security/performance deposit.

6.5 Short supply, damaged goods, or goods not conforming to specifications shall be rejected and the supplier must replace them at their own cost within 7 (seven) working days of intimation.

7. QUALITY ASSURANCE & INSPECTION

7.1 The District Administration or its authorised committee reserves the right to inspect, test, and verify the quality and specifications of goods at any stage — before dispatch, at the time of delivery, or post-installation.

7.2 The supplier shall provide samples, test reports, or certificates of conformance as required.

7.3 Third-party inspection by a Government-approved agency may be conducted at the expense of the District Administration, if deemed necessary.

7.4 Items found to be sub-standard, counterfeit, or non-compliant shall be returned to the supplier at the supplier's cost, and full replacement must be made.

8. WARRANTY & POST-SALE SUPPORT

8.1 Minimum Warranty Period:

- Road Divider: 1 (One) Year from date of acceptance.
-

- Wheel Locker: 1 (One) Year from date of acceptance.
- Breath Analyser: 2 (Two) Years from date of acceptance (comprehensive on-site warranty).

8.2 During the warranty period, all defects, malfunctions, or failures attributable to manufacturing defects or material quality shall be rectified / replaced by the supplier at no cost to the Government.

8.3 For Breath Analysers, the supplier shall provide:

- Periodic calibration services as per manufacturer's recommendation during the warranty period.
- Technical support helpline accessible on all working days.
- On-site repair within 3 (three) working days of a complaint being lodged.

8.4 Warranty cards, service manuals, and calibration records must be handed over to the District Administration at the time of delivery.

9. GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

9.1 Validity of Tender: The quoted rates shall remain valid and binding for a minimum period of 90 (ninety) days from the date of opening of Tenders.

9.2 Forfeiture / Termination: The District Administration reserves the right to terminate the Supply Order at any stage in case of fraud, misrepresentation, or persistent non-compliance, and may blacklist the firm/supplier for future procurement.

9.3 Force Majeure: Neither party shall be liable for failure or delay in performance if such failure is caused by circumstances beyond reasonable control (natural disasters, war, Government orders), provided timely written notice is given.

9.4 Subletting: The supplier shall not sublet, transfer, or assign the supply order or any part thereof to any other party without prior written approval of the District Administration.

9.5 Canvassing: Any bidder found to be canvassing or influencing the evaluation process shall be disqualified.

9.6 Right to Accept / Reject: The undersigned reserves the right to accept or reject any or all Tenders, cancel the entire tender process, or modify quantities, without assigning any reason thereof, and without any liability to the bidders.

9.7 Splitting of Orders: The District Administration reserves the right to split the order between two or more bidders in the interest of public service.

9.8 Governing Law & Jurisdiction: This Notice and any resultant contract shall be governed by the laws of India. Legal jurisdiction for any dispute arising here from shall vest exclusively in the competent courts of Sonitpur (Tezpur) District, Assam.

9.9 Dispute Resolution: In the event of a dispute, the matter shall first be referred to the District Commissioner, Sonitpur for resolution. If unresolved, it shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the appropriate court.

9.10 Bids not in conformity with all the above conditions are liable to be rejected without further notice.
