The Meeting was chaired by Sri Anuran Medhi, Assistant Commissioner, Barchalla, Sonitpur and co-chaired by Md. Jane Alam, Assistant Commissioner, Barchalla, Sonitpur. At the very outset, the Chair welcomed all the members present in the meeting.

After that the meeting discussed elaborately and emphasized on the following aspects:

Infrastructure	PHE	1.JJM 2.SBM-G	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The Chair reviewed the overall status report of the PHE Division II under Barchalla LAC : <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Total Schemes:-235, ➤ Completed and handed over schemes as on 18/05/2026:-198, ➤ Ongoing schemes as on 18/05/2026:-37, ➤ Total Non –Operative scheme as on 18/05/2026:-22 The Department informed that the defunct schemes under JJM were mainly due to leakage in pipe, boring-related and transformer related issues. The Chair directed the officials to take follow up actions for the defunct schemes and take necessary steps and resolve the issues at the earliest to restore functionality of the defunct schemes. • The Official informed regarding issues related to tariff collection. Out of the 198 handed over schemes, water tariff collection is being carried out in only 65 schemes. • The Chair reviewed the progress of works under SBM-G. The Official informed that out of 15 Nos. of Community Managed Sanitary Complex (CMSC), 7 schemes have been handed over. The Chair further reviewed the status of works related to the end-of-drainage system and Community Compost Pit.

2.	Infrastructure	PWD (Building)	1.RIDF	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • The officials informed the meeting regarding the status of the 8 ongoing Jagannath Community Hall-cum-Skill Centres. The physical progress of the works is as follows: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Belsiri T.E - 77%, ➤ Hirajuli T.E - 80% ➤ Shyamaguri T.E - 95%. • Regarding the land-related issue pertaining to the work of Construction of Model School at Belsiri TE, under RIDF XXVIII, involving the proposed Cycle stand and Kitchen over approximately 2.5 - 3 bighas of land, the Chair directed the Department to resolve the issue in coordination with the concerned Circle Officer and Tea Estate Authorities and to take necessary follow-up action at the earliest. • The Official further apprised the Chair regarding the land related issue pertaining to the scheme "Construction of Chandra Nath Sarma Govt. Model College" and also that the matter has already been intimated to the District Commissioner, Sonitpur. • The Official further apprised the Chair regarding a new project of Construction of Bihaguri H.S. School under RIDF XXXI. • The Chair took note of the progress of the Construction of Model Secondary School in Silikhabari HSS and Super Speciality Hospital at TMCH. The Chair instructed the Official to expedite the progress of both the works and ensure their timely completion.

Infrastructure	Water Resources	1.ADB 2.RIDF 3.SOPD(G)	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Under the Climate Resilient Brahmaputra Integrated Flood and Riverbank Erosion Risk Management Project in Assam including the additional high-priority works at Jarani, the Department reported that the physical progress of the work has reached 95%, and the remaining work is currently in progress. • The Chair enquired about the flood prone areas in the region, to which the officials informed the meeting regarding flood-related issues at Gabharu and Belsiri. • The Official apprised the Chair regarding a land status issue related to a new project of Bhora Singori under Thelamara Circle. The Chair asked the official to coordinate with the Circle Officer to resolve the issue. • Regarding the project of strengthening of both bank embankments of river Gabharu at different inadequate sections & anti-erosion measure at Kalakuchi & Ghatua on R/B & Saraka on L/B from the erosion of river Gabharu under RIDF -XXIX, the department informed that the work has been physically completed. • The Official further apprised the Chair regarding Construction of a new embankment from Block-Centre to 1 No. Bosa Simalu on the R/Bank of

				<p>river Brahmaputra under SOPD (G) scheme which has achieved around 85% physical progress.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Chair directed the Official to closely monitor all the schemes and update the progress of the schemes to the undersigned on a time to time basis.

Building and other Construction Workers' (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996.</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Official apprised the Chair that there are no flagship schemes under the department. However, various welfare benefits are being provided under the Building and Other Construction Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Service) Act, 1996, including Death Benefit, Funeral Assistance, General Pension, Family Pension, One-Time Educational Assistance, Maternity Assistance, and other similar support measures.
5.	Economic Development	Agriculture	<p>1.PADDY PROCURMENT 2.PM-KISAN 3.PMFBY</p>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Official informed the Chair that under NFSNM Commercial Crop and Mission Atmanirbharta in Pulse, the distribution of Certified Jute Seeds, Var- JROG- 1 , JROB-2 and Distribution of Blackgram seeds, Var- SBC -40 is currently ongoing. The department informed that under Paddy Procurement 2025-26 against the target of 10000 MT Paddy procurement for KMS (1st crop) as on 25/04/2026, a total of 6499.16 MT has been procured till date, achieving 64.99% of the target benefiting 725 farmers. Under PM-KISAN, the Chair was informed that the 22nd installment has been received for 8,102 beneficiaries. It was further informed that no new work has been taken up as the portal has remained closed for the last three months. The Chair enquired whether any innovative schemes have been undertaken in the region. In response, the official informed that initiatives such as low-cost bamboo housing, vermicomposting, and floriculture-related projects have been undertaken. With regard to vermicomposting, the Chair directed the officials to coordinate with the concerned Block and involve NGOs for its effective utilization, ensuring that no waste is generated. The Chair directed the formation of a committee to conduct a survey of agricultural land on which any industry is operating.

Economic Development	Animal husbandry and Veterinary	1.Vaccination	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The official apprised the Chair that under the NADCP, vaccination against Foot and Mouth Disease and Classical Swine Fever is ongoing, for which progress of 15% and 9.09% has been achieved, respectively. The Department informed the Chair regarding the National Digital Livestock Mission (Bharat

				<p>Pashudhan Aadhar seeding) under which a progress of 27.78 % has been achieved.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> The official further apprised the house regarding mobile veterinary unit(MVU), with toll free no is 1962 . Under this initiative, the department dispatches MVUs directly to farmers' doorsteps to provide on-site treatments, minor surgeries and emergency medical assistance for livestock. A total of 54 cases have been attended through this service.

Infrastructure	Health	1.NVBDCP	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Out of a target of 1% of the total population, 1,186 girls under the age of 14 have been identified for the HPV vaccination drive, of whom 524 have been vaccinated till date. The Chair discussed the National Vector Borne Disease Control Programme(NVBDCP) and took a note on the data related to the HBNC visit against institutional delivery & home deliveries. The Chair directed to increase the vaccination drives against various programmes in the department.

Economic Development	Fishery	1.PMMSY 2.ADB-SWIFT	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Department informed that under ADB-SWIFT, tender completed and work may be started from August, 2026 for the ongoing projects namely Dev. of Dighali Beel(Selected under Phase-I) and Dev. of Borakata Beel .Works have been completed both physically and financially 100% under PMMSY 2024-25. Under RIDF-XXIX ,50% of the activity for fisheries entrepreneurship development in Assam through pond aquaculture has been completed physically. Under Group Accidental Insurance Scheme (GAIS): Submitted 2150 nos .The Official further informed that under Fish farmers and other stake holder's registration in NFDP (National Fisheries Digital Platform): 1560 nos. already registered. Registration and verification going on.

Revenue Collected in the year 2026-27 till Date: 223878195 (10.13%) Five nos. of wine shops are operating in Barchalla Co-district showing an increase in consumption by 138% in IMFL and 157% in Beer. The Chair directed for active inspections to be conducted against sale of illicit liquor in Barchalla co-district.

Infrastructure	PWD (Roads), Barchalla & Dhekiajuli Territorial Road Division	1.MMUPPNA	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Chair directed the official to look into the matter related to a complaint received from Chariduar T.E manager regarding approach road under Asom Mala. Regarding the issue of water logging in National Highway Area of Rowmari, the Chair directed that a meeting be convened with the concerned official and the Circle Officer to resolve the matter.

				<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Chair reviewed the ongoing schemes of the department and emphasized timely completion of all works. The Accredited Engineer of Bihaguri Development Block raised an issue on Bhergaon-Naharbari road where road accidents are frequent due to the poor condition of the road and the matter could not be resolved through MGNREGA. The Chair directed the official from PWD(Roads) to look into the matter and take necessary follow up actions.

The Chair took note of the production report of the private sector of Sericulture Deptt. for the month of April, 2026 for Eri Raw Silk, Muga Raw Silk and Mulberry Raw Silk.
13.	Infrastructure	Irrigation	1.SOPD 2.NABARD	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Chair reviewed the overall progress of the schemes under SOPD-G and NABARD pertaining to the department. The official informed that there are 6 nos. of schemes under SOPD-G with an overall progress of 43% and 3 nos. of schemes under NABARD with overall 75% progress.

Infrastructure	Transport	1.Revenue Target 2.Revenue Collection.	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Official informed that for the financial year 2026-27, the revenue target for Sonitpur district was Rs.89.05 Cr out of which Rs. 9,11,24,336 revenue has been collected from 01/04/2026 to 17/05/2026 with 10.23% of achievement. The Chair directed that the rate of road accidents, especially during night hours, be examined and surprise inspections be conducted.

Social Sector	Panchayat & Rural Development	1.PMAY-G 2.Amrit Sarovar	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Chair reviewed progress of the works under PMAY-G,MGNREGA,15th Finance Commission Schemes, Amrit Sarovar and Model AWCs under both the development blocks. The Chair sought a detail report on Model AWCs and Amrit Sarovar against both the blocks.

Infrastructure	Power		<ul style="list-style-type: none"> The Chair enquired regarding works under Panbari Sub –station to which the official informed that the overall progress is 97.69% with a financial progress of 95.19%. The official further apprised the Chair regarding awareness programs and Street play organized by the department for better understanding of smart metering system.
